Since 2005, Brevard Family Partnership (BFP) has been the lead child welfare agency responsible for the safety, stability and well-being of abused, neglected, or abandoned children in Brevard County. BFP and its community partners provide child abuse prevention, foster care and support, adoption, independent living and community outreach services to the children and families of Brevard County.

Our goal is to keep children and families together in their local community and school when safe and appropriate to do so; and to find forever families for children who cannot safely return home.





OTHER WAYS TO GET INVOLVED

Volunteers are trained to form a "Table" and develop long-term relationships with the "Friend" - the individual or family they are serving. Guided by a Life Plan defined by the Friend, Table members and the friend access their social networks to support implementation of the Life Plan. Tables range from four to twelve volunteers based on needs and number of family members. Over the course of a year, Tables meet weekly for an hour and share friendship and activities outside of Table meetings.
