For 11 months I took care of the girls. They wore me out, but I loved those girls like my own. After 11 months in my care, the girls and their brothers were reunified with their mother. My heart was both happy and broken at the same time as I watched the girls go back home. How could I continue this?

Three days later, I received my answer when their mother called to ask me about personal hygiene and bedtime routines for the kiddos. We were just two moms chatting about their kids! I am thankful for the relationship their mom and I built while the girls were in my care. She comes to me when she needs parenting advice or help.




